#### **Camp Fees and Financial Assistance**

Our best camper fees are for registrations postmarked **before April 15**, **2015**. All registrations postmarked prior to April 15 are eligible for a \$50 discount for week long camps (price in the early bird column). *Financial assistance is available*. #### **HIGH SCHOOL CAMP**


