



Professor & Mrs. Allen Fuhs CSUMB-KQED Scholarship in Science Media Communication

Dr. Fuhs believes in the importance of clearly communicating science concepts to the general public. To that end, he is providing a one year \$10,000 scholarship and a \$10,000 summer internship in science communication at KQED Public Media in San Francisco to a CSUMB student.

Applications are being accepted now beginning with the 2015 summer internship and the academic year beginning Fall 2015.

Selection Criteria:

1. Junior, Senior or Graduate student status by Summer 2015.
2. Declared Science Major in the College of Science.
3. Demonstrated interest in science communication.
4. In good academic standing with a GPA of 3.0 or higher.

To apply, students meeting the criteria will be required to provide:

1. An essay identifying their career interests in connection with science communication.
2. The name of a science faculty, who knows the student's work, is informed of the student's interest in the scholarship and internship and will recommend them for this award.


