2015 AJFCA GOODMAN AWARD
(The deadline for submissions is February 6, 2015)

The Board of Directors of the Association of Jewish Family & Children's Agencies is pleased to announce the eighth competition for the Goodman Award for Innovative Programming, named in memory of AJFCA Honorary Board Chair Henry Goodman. This Award will be presented at the 2015 AJFCA Annual Conference.

THE JUDGES: The Goodman Award Committee will be composed of representatives from AJFCA's membership and staffed by the AJFCA office.

THE SUCCESSFUL ENTRY: AJFCA is looking for a creative, sustainable and replicable program of an AJFCA member agency that responds to a community problem. The winning program must have at least two of the following components: a Jewish component, an outreach component, and a community-building component. The program must have been established after January 1, 2012. The Award competition is open to all agencies, regardless of size. Programs that were previously submitted but did not win may be re-entered as long as they are still less than three years old.

THE SUBMISSION FORMAT: To submit an application for the Goodman Award, please fill in the Goodman Award Submission Form, save it as a Word document and email it to Liz Woodward at lwoodward@ajfca.org. All submission forms must be completed in 12 point Times New Roman font, have one inch margins, and be no longer than two pages. You will receive a confirmation email for all submissions. If you do not, please contact Liz Woodward to ensure your submission was received.

DEADLINE: Submissions must be received on or before **Friday, February 6, 2015**.

QUALIFICATIONS: In order to win the Goodman Award, the sponsoring agency must be a member in good standing of the Association of Jewish Family and Children's Agencies. Both a volunteer and professional leader must represent the winning agency at the Conference in Miami.

THE PRIZE: The agency and their winning entry will be recognized at the Plenary Breakfast on Monday, May 4th. The agency will receive a beautiful glass sculpture, created specifically for the award, one free conference registration, and the opportunity to present the winning program at a workshop session.
