

# Members Club Entertainment System Control Guide

#### BEFORE YOU START GET TO KNOW YOUR REMOTE



## **The Basics**



The OFF button is for turning off all system components. This button will not turn components ON.

This is the HOME button for the remote. This will take you back to the activities page on the touchscreen.

This button takes to you the HELP menu when something does not come on or operate as expected.

Press the HELP button and follow the prompts on the touchscreen to resolve the problem.

When in doubt, press the OFF button to power the system down and start again from the HOME screen.

#### **To Watch Cable TV**



Simply touch the Watch TV button on the touchscreen. The button will turn a darker blue. The remote will power up the correct devices and set up the system to watch

The remote will land on the FAVORITES page. All the buttons on the remote are now controlling the TV and Cable Box.

You can tap on a channel from the favorites screen and it will take you to that channel on the TV. Note the four dots at the top of the Favorites page. You can swipe left or right to access the next page. The four pages on this activity are:

- 1. Favorites
- 2. DVR Buttons
- 3. Number/Channel Buttons
- 4. Home Screen



## **The Basics**

**ALWAYS** use the **Harmony Remote Control to** operate the system. When the system is off, the remote will be at the **HOME SCREEN.** 



The buttons on the touch screen are Activity Buttons.

You can swipe the screen up or down to expose more activities.

There are a total of 7 Activities:

- 1. Watch TV
- 2. Watch DVD
- 3. Watch Apple TV
- 4. Listen to FM
- 5. Listen to AUX
- 6. Watch Smart TV
- 7. Side Wall HDMI

## **TO WATCH A DVD**



Tap the Watch a DVD button on the touchscreen. The remote will power on devices needed to Watch a DVD.

The remote will land on the DVD home page.

Now all of the buttons on the remote are for watching a DVD or Netflix within the DVD player

## **To Listen to FM Radio**



## **Listen to Aux**



Simply tap the Listen to AUX button on the home screen

The only buttons active in this setting are the Volume +/-

Plug in your iPod, iPad, iPhone, or other smartphone/tablet using the headphone jack on your device and the 1/8" cable next to the remote charging cradle.

You can now play your music content over the speakers.



## Watch Smart TV



Tap the Watch Smart TV button on the Home Screen

All of the buttons on the remote are used to control the Smart TV functions.
