DRAFT AMENDMENT 6 TO THE 2006 CONSOLIDATED HIGHLY MIGRATORY SPECIES

This amendment proposes a range of management measures for the commercial shark fisheries to respond to the problems facing these fisheries, such as commercial landings that exceed the quotas, declining numbers of fishing permits since limited access was implemented, complex regulations, derby fishing conditions due to small quotas and short seasons, increasing numbers of regulatory discards, and declining market prices.
