served 3812 children from 1466 families from August 2014 to January 2015. With a new year comes new resolutions: time to lose weight, get healthy, volunteer more, organize the house, be mindful of others, go to church, pray more, thank God for the gifts we have been given, and the list goes on and on.

Christ Child can help you on your quest of completing your 2015 goals. Want to volunteer more? For those who have never attended a ND women's basketball game, we suggest you get a ticket soon. It is great fun. Not only are the ND fans loyal and loud; they also are a very generous bunch. Promotions are held during various home games. The 2014 Teddy Bear Toss was a huge success. This year, Christ Child shared the bears with Memorial Children's hospital. At halftime, spectators are invited to "toss" their bears on to the court. That is a sight! Not only are bears as small as beanie babies thrown, but also full size build-a-bear stuffed animals fly through the air. The hardwood on court could not be seen: it was a sea of stuffed toys. Volunteers from Memorial Hospital, cheerleaders, Christ Child members, friends and family all jumped into action and stuffed those bears into trash bags. In all, 42 bags were stuffed full of animals! Christ Child brought 21 bags to the clothing center for distribution next year.
