

TOUR MEMBERSHIP

Please complete the tour membership registration form and return to TEMPO TRAVEL SERVICE, INC. Please provide your name as it appears on your passport, including your date of birth, phone number and email contacts, with the required deposit.

DEPOSITS & PAYMENTS

A deposit of \$300 per person is required for your membership, to be sent with your completed tour membership registration form. An invoice will be sent to you showing amounts and deadline for subsequent payments. In general, 50% of the remaining tour balance will be due Dec. 1, 2015, and the remaining 50% of the tour cost will be due February 1, 2016. Credit cards will only be accepted for the air transportation portion of your tour. In order to keep the tour price as low as possible, payments for the land touring portion of the tour will be by check only payable to TEMPO TRAVEL SERVICE, INC.

CANCELLATION & TRAVEL INSURANCE

All payments received will be non-refundable after September 1, 2015. Travel insurance is recommended, and an application will be sent with your preliminary invoice.

AIR TRANSPORTATION

Flights for this tour will be selected and announced by September 1, 2015. Any travel dates other than official tour dates can be requested, and if this results in a higher fare, you will be given the option when you make your request. If you would like to arrange your own air transportation, you can request that a credit of the value of the flight portion of your tour be subtracted from your invoice. If your flights arrive and/or depart on the same days but at different times from the group, you may need to pay extra for ground transportation to/from the airport. Any changes after your tickets are issued may result in a change fee and possible higher fare being owed.

ITINERARY

Day 1: Tuesday, May 17

Today we depart from the Midwest (Milwaukee or Chicago) on overnight transatlantic flights to Berlin.

Day 2: Wednesday, May 18 (D)

We arrive in Berlin this morning. After claiming our luggage, we will make some stops in this important city for sightseeing, including the Brandenburg Gate, Checkpoint Charlie, the Kaiser Wilhelm Church, and Berlin Cathedral. This evening we will have a welcoming dinner.
OVERNIGHT in BERLIN

Day 3: Thursday, May 19 (B,D)

We depart this morning for LUTHERSTADT WITTENBERG, the site which was the beginning of the Reformation of the Church. Get acclimated to the important landmarks in this important city, with a walking tour of the Altstadt, and a visit to the Old Latin School (owned and operated by the LCMS).
OVERNIGHT in WITTENBERG

Day 4: Friday, May 20 (B)

We have a full day of activities in Wittenberg. Today we become familiar with the Castle Church and the Church of St. Mary, as well as the Lutherhaus and Melancthonhaus.
OVERNIGHT in WITTENBERG

Day 5: Saturday, May 21 (B, D)

We depart this morning for Leipzig, and we visit the St. Nicolas Church, site of the peaceful revolution and reunification movement.
OVERNIGHT in LEIPZIG

Day 6: Sunday, May 22 (B)

Sunday morning worship at St. Thomas Kirche (where J. S. Bach was cantor for over 25 years). Free afternoon, or for those interested, we will take a side trip to the city of Dresden, visit the Frauenkirche, Bruhl's Terrace, the Catholic Hofkirche, and see the Golden Horseman.
OVERNIGHT in LEIPZIG

Day 7: Monday, May 23 (B, D)

Depart Leipzig this morning for Eisleben, the place of birth and death for Martin Luther. Following visits to both the birth and death houses, we continue for Erfurt.
OVERNIGHT in ERFURT

Day 8: Tuesday, May 24 (B, D)

This morning we visit the Augustinian Monastery where Luther lived and studied, and tour the Old University area, and Kramer Bridge. After some free time, we depart Erfurt for Eisenach.
OVERNIGHT in EISENACH

Day 9: Wednesday, May 25 (B, D)

This morning we visit Wartburg Castle, where Luther was hidden for his protection, and where you will see the study where he translated the Bible into German. Next we visit the Cotta House, where Luther stayed during his student days, possibly see the birthplace of J. S. Bach. Continue this afternoon to Frankfurt. Time permitting, we will visit Trinity Lutheran Church in Frankfurt, our LCMS mission site. Farewell dinner tonight.
OVERNIGHT in FRANKFURT

Day 10: Thursday, May 26

Group will depart today on flights back to the US.
