FLY OF THE MONTH - Pat Dorsey's Top Secret Midge



Wintertime is midge time and here is an easy to tie very effective midge pattern. It is Pat Dorsey's Top Secret Midge.

Recipe:

Hook: Tiemco 2488 sizes #18-24

Thread: Brown 8/0 Rib: White thread 8/0

Wing: White Flouro Fiber half the body length

Head: Rusty brown Superfine dubbing

Tying Instructions:

- 1. Crush down the hook barb and tie-in the thread at about three eye lengths back from the eye or about the 3/4 point.
- 2. At the tie-in point tie-in the rib material at the side of the hook shank.
- 3. Wrap the thread rearward and down the bend covering the rib material.
- 4. Wrap the thread forward in tight side by side wraps back up to the tie-in point.
- 5. Wrap the thread rib forward in open spirals to the tie-in point trim.
- 6. Tie-in a sparse wing at the tie-in point pointing rearward. Trim at 1/2 the body length.
- 7. Dub a head of superfine dubbing from the tie-in point forward to the eye forming a nice round head.
- 8. Whip finish.
