

FLY OF THE MONTH – *Pat Dorsey's Top Secret Midge*

Wintertime is midge time and here is an easy to tie very effective midge pattern. It is Pat Dorsey's Top Secret Midge.



Recipe:

Hook: Tiemco 2488 sizes #18-24

Thread: Brown 8/0

Rib: White thread 8/0

Wing: White Flouro Fiber half the body length

Head: Rusty brown Superfine dubbing

Tying Instructions:

1. Crush down the hook barb and tie-in the thread at about three eye lengths back from the eye or about the 3/4 point.
2. At the tie-in point tie-in the rib material at the side of the hook shank.
3. Wrap the thread rearward and down the bend covering the rib material.
4. Wrap the thread forward in tight side by side wraps back up to the tie-in point.
5. Wrap the thread rib forward in open spirals to the tie-in point - trim.
6. Tie-in a sparse wing at the tie-in point pointing rearward. Trim at 1/2 the body length.
7. Dub a head of superfine dubbing from the tie-in point forward to the eye forming a nice round head.
8. Whip finish.
