- 4. AUTOBIOGRAPHICAL ESSAY, typed in 500 words or less, attached to the application. Some of the topics to cover are: who you are, your interests, community services for which you have volunteered, hobbies, your career goal, your heroes, family relationships, your link to Japanese heritage, and your interest, if any, in Japanese culture. Quality, neatness, and clarity are vital.
- 5. REQUEST FORM (this completed form)

All five items listed above must be enclosed for consideration. The winner will be selected based on academic record, community service and extracurricular involvement, quality of essay, letter of recommendation, and clarity of application, and in case of a tie, need. Scholarship may be applied to any college, university, community college, fine arts, or technical school. The award is \$1,000.
