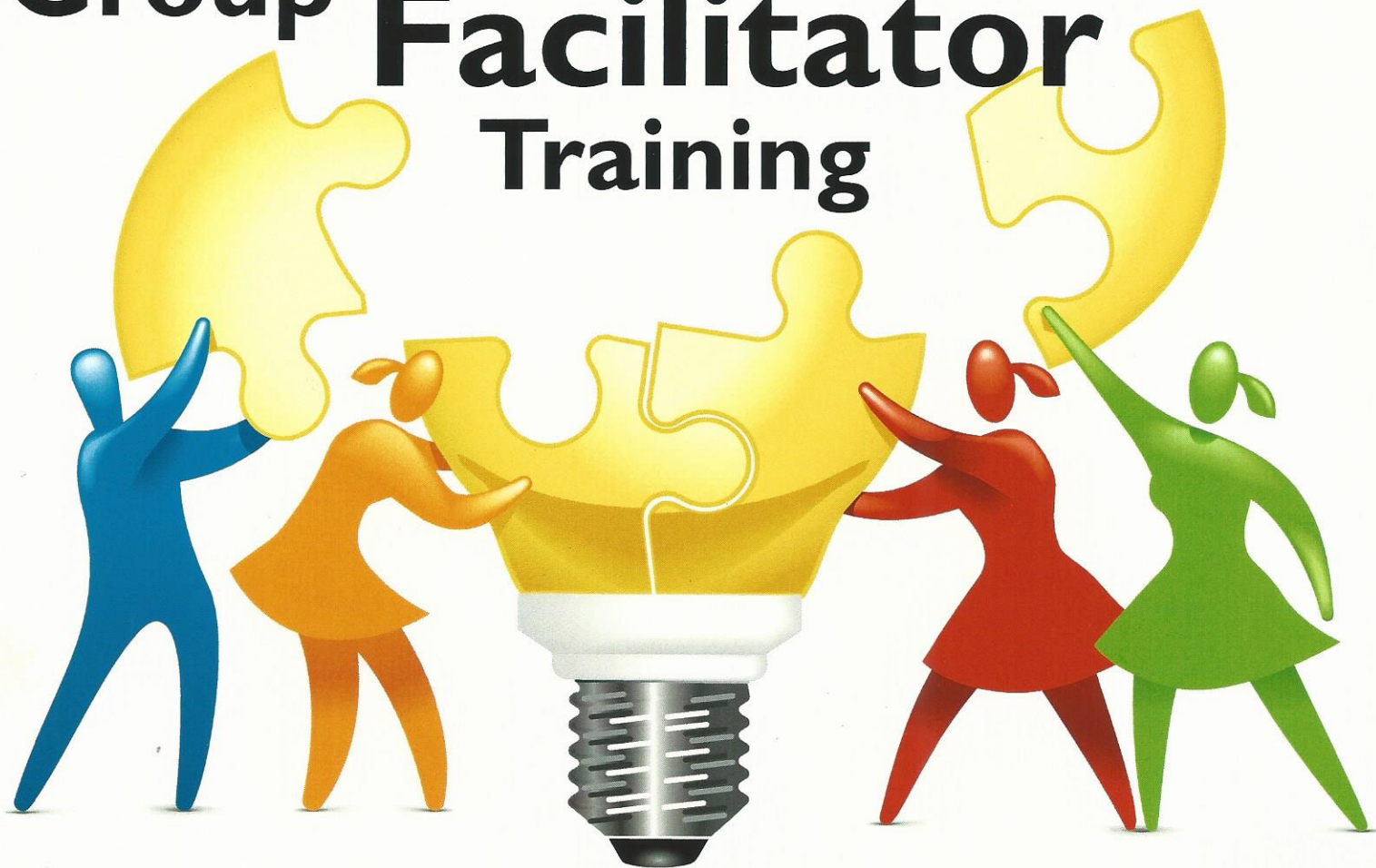


Group Facilitator Training
