

WEATHER POLICY

In the event of adverse weather or unplayable field conditions, the tournament director reserves the right to:

- Reduce game times in order to catch up with schedule
- Finish games before inclement weather arrives, or to preserve field conditions
- Reschedule games, if possible
- Convert tournament to a "festival" format without playoffs or championships to provide the majority of teams the opportunity to play as many games as possible

Every attempt will be made to update cancellations via email. However, weather conditions can change rapidly and all teams should be prepared to play as soon as the weather clears. The directors of DVA, DC-Sports, and KGBA reserve the right to cancel, shorten, or reschedule games due to inclement weather, poor playing conditions, and or concerns for player and fan safety. No refunds will be granted if these actions are necessary. Tournament directors will communicate game changes.

THUNDER & LIGHTNING POLICY

If thunder and or lightning is observed, play will be suspended immediately and players and fans will be asked to leave the beach and return to cars. Play will be allowed to resume 20 minutes after the last sound of thunder or sign of lightning is observed which will be determined by the tournament medical staff or director. Every attempt will be made to begin subsequent games on time. Subsequent games will begin immediately after preceding games.

REFUND POLICY

There is a no refund policy for this event. If a player requests a refund before the day of the event, the player can be given a credit for any other we run of equal or lesser value.
