

Main Street Squeeze

RIVERSIDE COUNTY TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION

The "Main Street Squeeze" is coming to Main Street in Corona for the 91 Project. Starting January 20, northbound and southbound travel on Main Street will be reduced to two lanes in each direction between the westbound 91 ramps and Third Street. Also starting January 20, the eastbound on-ramp will be closed for approximately 15 months. Lincoln Avenue will serve as the detour with Magnolia Avenue and Hidden Valley Parkway as alternate routes. Please see map on reverse.

The lane reductions and ramp closure will allow crews to rebuild the bridge, relocate utilities, lower the Main Street roadway, construct walls and widen sidewalks. In addition, Main Street will be widened at the request of the City of Corona to improve local traffic flow. Later this year, a full closure of the Main Street westbound off-ramp will be required for approximately 10 - 12 months.

At a later date, left turns onto the westbound 91 on-ramp for northbound Main Street motorists may be restricted.
