Process

The Committee met on January 6, 2015, to develop a draft of the 2015-2016 academic calendar to submit to the Superintendent by reviewing the following:

- 1. Results from the 2015-2016 District Calendar Staff Survey
- 2. 2015-2016 New Trier High School Calendar
- 3. State of Illinois school calendar requirements
- 4. Committee representative input

In addition to considering the above information, the Committee took the following priorities into account that emerged from staff input as they constructed the school calendar:

- 1. Review the possibility of a later start date to mitigate heat issues to the extent possible.
- 2. Align winter and spring break with the New Trier High School Calendar
- 3. Determine dates for the two additional Teacher Institute Days
- 4. Align the winter conference dates for grades 1-8
- 5. Adjust the last day to school to a half-day of attendance for students.

The Committee was also interested in preserving as many five-day weeks as possible to maintain instructional continuity for both students and teachers.

Attached to this memo is the preliminary proposal for the 2015-2016 School Calendar entitled List of Days Out of School. This version includes start and end dates, as well as vacation dates and holidays, during which students will not be in school.

It is recommended that the School Board approve the calendar as presented at its meeting on February 24, 2015.
