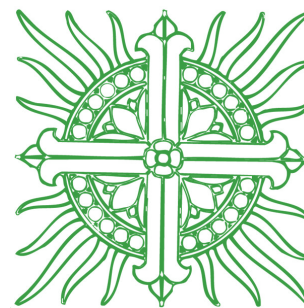

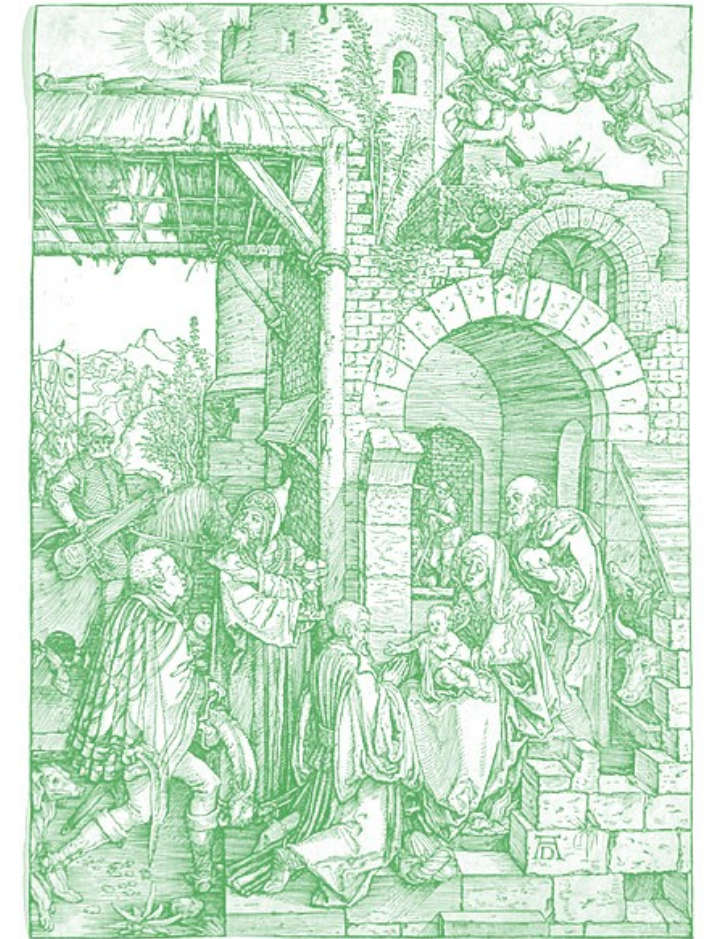
### THE CATHEDRAL MISSION STATEMENT
