Current Work

Despite freezing mornings and the occasional bout with snow, the project moves forward through the winter months. Most work, aside from landscaping, can be done during these chilly months with the right precautions taken. The most temperature sensitive work is concreting, but through using proper techniques to combat cold weather such using as temperature controlled blankets, the project has been successfully continuing to place new curb lines throughout the western end.
